HE LEADS WITH OBEDIENCE

A warrior doesn't chase applause—he follows orders. He answers to a King. Even when no one sees, he obeys. His strength starts with surrender.

'And he said to all, 'If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me.'

HE MASTERS HIMSELF

He rules his mind, body, and emotions. He trains for the fight and stays watchful. He disciplines his habits and rejects distraction. He sharpens what God has entrusted to him.
